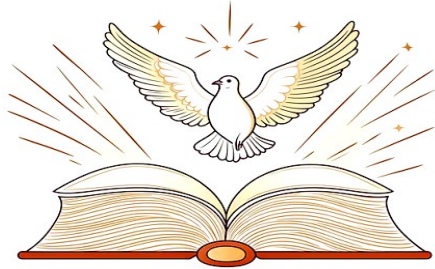


Celebration of Ministries - May 10, 2026
