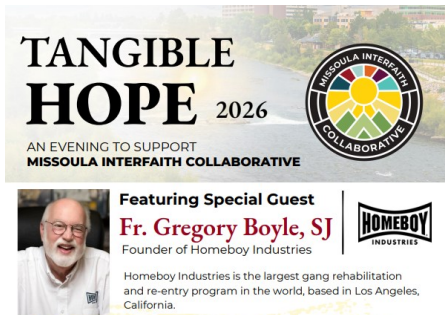


Nursery Attendant Needed
