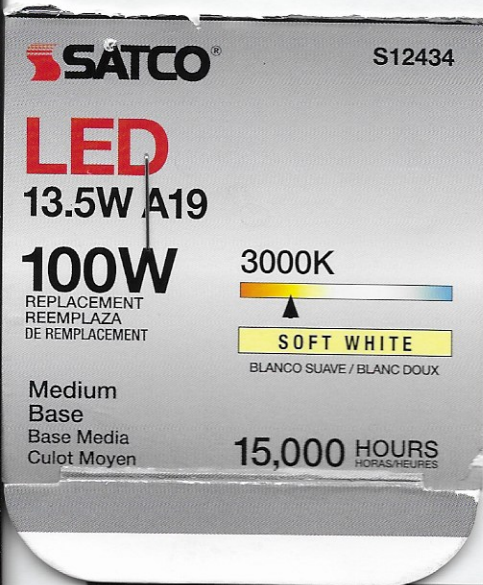

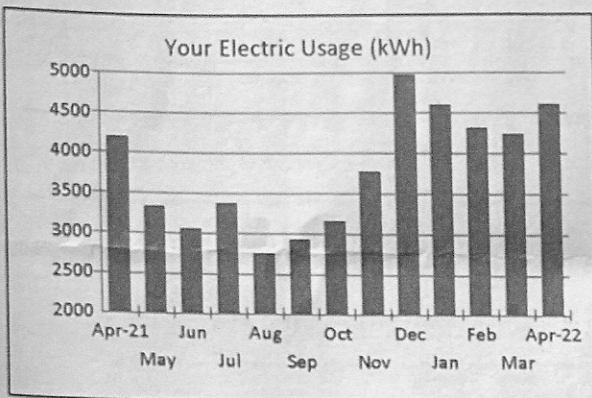

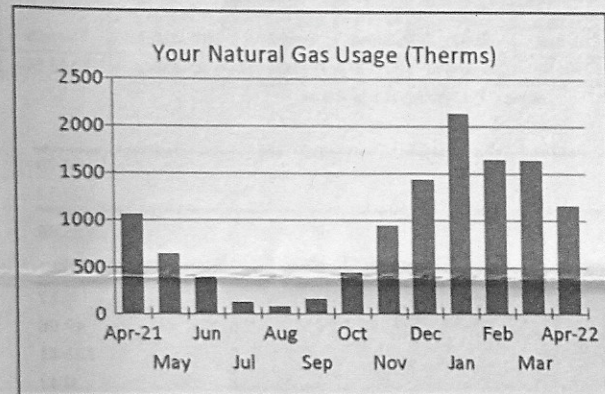

Purpose of Form
